

Ojibways of Onigaming

KAL provided engineering services to design the Ojibways of Onigaming First Nation's wastewater treatment facility to service the communities projected 20-year wastewater flows while meeting the <u>Guidelines for Effluent Quality and wastewater Treatment at Federal Establishments</u>, from Environment Canada.

The wastewater treatment facility consists of a three cell facultative lagoon facility that includes:

- ➤ Two (2) facultative treatment cells (Cell #1 & Cell #2) with combined total treatment area of 51.4 ha and a hydraulic storage capacity of 68,721 m³.
- ➤ One (1) storage cell (Cell #3) with a hydraulic storage capacity of 45,153 m³.

The lagoon cells were designed to conform to the existing terrain.
