A new commercial development site is currently under construction at the intersection of Wellington Street and 5th Avenue in Sioux Lookout. The first business constructed was a Tim Hortons which opened its doors in April, 2013.

The Municipality of Sioux Lookout retained Keewatin-Aski Ltd. (KAL) to prepare a Traffic Impact Study to evaluate traffic impacts on the existing intersection level of service and to recommend improvements that will ensure an acceptable level of service is maintained under full build-out conditions. - → Cost Estimate of Recommended Improvements
